Thanks to many national IP offices, MGS can be used worldwide. It provides validated terms of goods and services in different languages:

Arabic, Chinese (simplified and traditional), Dutch, English, French, German, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Norwegian, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish and Turkish.

- MGS is the gateway to a large and evolving database of goods and services;
- It provides high-quality data that are pre-accepted by WIPO and many IP offices in the Madrid system;
- MGS offers information about terms that are rejected by participating IP offices;
- It covers International Nice Classification terms as well as a much wider choice of pre-accepted terms translated into all MGS languages.

- Simply select the desired language to search for terms.
- Compile – with a few clicks – a list of goods and services using terms that are correctly classified and accepted by WIPO.
- “Check WIPO acceptance” for free text descriptions and, if necessary, “Search related terms” that are pre-accepted.
- Get an instant translation into any MGS language.
- Use the exclusive “CHECK ACCEPTANCE BY dCP” feature to see which terms in your list are accepted or rejected by designated Contracting Parties (dCP).
 - Export and import your list at your own convenience.

Saving Time and Money

- With MGS, you can compile the complete list of goods and services needed to file a trademark application using pre-accepted terms. This helps reduce delays and costs linked to irregularity notices from WIPO.
- You can also see which goods and services terms are rejected by participating IP offices for the Contracting Parties designated in your application. This can reduce delays and costs linked to provisional refusals.
