Honey from Vlasina

Description:

Honey from Vlasina is honey from meadow produced mostly from herbs, in general having healing properties, and fruit, exclusively by stationary or modified stationary manner of bee keeping on the area on the district of Vlasina, by extracting honey by means of a separator or centrifuge of the closed frames with completely mature honey. Thanks to the pollen analysis, it has been proven that there is significant presence of the fruit nectar, nectar of medical herbs and clover. In the composition of the honey from Vlasina there must not be more than 3% of the pollen from locust tree. Honey from Vlasina is the striking representative of the honey produced in the meadows. The intensity of color of the Honey from Vlasina varies from very light yellow, over the amber color with orange reddish tone to dark amber color. Immediately after the centrifuge, the honey from Vlasina is conspicuously transparent, of completely saturated and uniform pigmentation. While kept, it crystallizes very fast and it changes color then into lighter shades of yellow. The crystals of honey from Vlasina are small, fine and easily melted. The fragrance of the honey from Vlasina is from weak to middle intensity, with prominent herb and fruit aromatic tones transformed into the fragrance of mint. The aroma of honey is extremely pleasant with clearly domineering mint tone of medical herbs that gives it fresh and aromatic note.

Geographical area:

The product with the geographical indication Honey from Vlasina is produced exclusively on the area of the Vlasina plain.
