**Honey from Deliblato sands** 

## **Description:**

Honey from Deliblato is flower honey obtained from locust tree, herbs, including some medical herbs such as hawthorn and fruits, exclusively by stationary or modified stationary manner of bee keeping on the area of Deliblato, in fact by extracting honey by means of a separator from covered frames with completely mature honey. In the composition of honey from Deliblato there must not be more than 5% of honey from sunflower and not more than 10% of honey from linden from the sands. The predominant part of the honey from Deliblato, minimum of 50% belongs to the honey from linden. The intensity of color of honey from Deliblato varies from very light, light yellow and amber color with the orange tone to dark amber color. Immediately after the centrifuge, the honey from Deliblato is quite transparent of completely saturated and uniform pigmentation. It crystalizes when sitting still and the speed of crystallization depend if there is linden in its composition, or oil seed rape. The smell of honey from Deliblato is of weak intensity with expressed herbal and fruit fragrance tones reminding of the smell of fresh flowers and smell of fresh wax.
