In the academic year 2020/2021, the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), the Patent Office of the Republic of Poland and the Jagiellonian University in Krakow, will jointly organize the 3rd edition of the Master's Degree Program in Intellectual Property and New Technologies from October 2020 to February 2022.

The content of this joint Program focuses on the most challenging issues related to intellectual property and new technologies (including new technologies and patent law; copyright in the digital era; commercial communication; data protection, privacy and personal rights on the Internet; Internet service providers' liability). Many IP specialists from the European IP institutions will provide lectures and workshops in this program.

In addition, in the 2020/2021 edition of the Program, there shall be a number of scholarships available on a competitive basis. WIPO scholarships are awarded solely to government officials and others working in the public sector such as universities, academies and research and development institutions. To be eligible candidates must be from developing countries, least developed countries (LDCs) or countries in transition. The scholarships cover return ticket, registration and tuition fees, full board and lodging and medical insurance. Visa costs, if any, are at the expense of participants. Successful applicants for WIPO scholarships are notified by the WIPO Academy. Thereafter they will be provided with relevant information, including travel arrangements.

Candidates considering applying for WIPO scholarships for the Program must apply by August 15th. All candidates for the WIPO scholarship must first apply for admission to the University and meet the University's entrance requirements.
