Honey from the mountain of Tara

Description:

"Honey from Tara" is the flower honey or honeydew honey, produced on the territory of the municipality of Bajina Bašta, with certain characteristics. The flower honey has the maximum amount of water 19%, maximum amount of saccharose 4gr/100gr of product. Minimum amount of diastase 18 DN, electrical conductivity not higher than 0.8mS/cm. Consistence is from dense fluid to crystal, with crystals of different size, of yellow colour, through the colour of amber with or without reddish tones to dark brown, of medium intensive smell from plants, grass, hay, flowers, fruit, wax, with medium sweet to mild medium acid smell of medium stability, sometimes mildly bitter or mildly acrid. The flower honey, as a rule, contains pollen of plants from the following families: Rosaceae, Asteraceae, Fabaceae, as well as pollen of at least four families from the group of the following twelve families: Lamiaceae, Apiaceae, Plantaginaceae, Ranunculuaceae, Boraginaceae, Brassicaceae, Cistaceae, Rubiaceae, Tiliaceae, Hypericaceae, Saxifragaceae, Poaceae, and it must not contain more than 2% of pollen of oil plant. More than 2% of sunflower and more that 5% of acacia. Honeydew honey has the maximum amount of water 19%, maximum amount of saccharose 4gr/100gr of product, minimum amount of diastase 18DN, electrical conductivity no less than 0.8 nS/cm, amount of glucoses and fructose no less than 45gr/100gr of product. Coexistence of dense fluid to crystal, with crystals of different size, of yellow color, through the color of amber with or without reddish tones to dark brown of middle intensive smell from plants, grass, hay, flowers, fruit, wax, of middle sweet to mild to middle acid smell, it is of medium stability, sometimes mildly bitter or mildly acrid. Honeydew honey, as a rule, contains pollen of the plants from the families: Rosaceae, Asteraceae, Fabaceae, as well as the pollen of plants of at least four families from the group of the following 12 families: Lamiaceae, Apiaceae, Plantaginaceae, Ranunculuaceae, Boraginaceae, Brassicaceae, Cistaceae, Rubiaceae, Tiliaceae, Hypericaceae, Saxifragaceae, Poaceae, and it must not contain more than 2% of pollen of the oil plant, more than 2% of pollen of sunflower and more than 5% of the pollen of acacia.

Geographical area: Honey from Tara is produced exclusively on the territory of the municipality Bajina Bašta.
